WHEN TO JUDGE YOUR BROTHER

STUDY 1

1. Judgment in the hands of Jesus.

John 5:22 - *For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:*

John 5:30 - *I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.*

Romans 14:10 - *But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.*

Romans 14:12-13a - *So theevery one of us shall give account of himself to God.
13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more:*

Romans 8:33 - *Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.*

2. Vengeance belongs to God.

Hebrews 10:30b - *.....Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.*

Romans 12:19b - *.....avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.*

Romans 12:20-21 - *Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.*

21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

3. Judge only by the Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:15 - *But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.*

(Little men sometimes make the mistake of proclaiming that they are always in the Spirit. Loose yourself from the bondage of such men.)

1 Corinthians 4:5a - *Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts:*

1 Corinthians 4:3-4 - *But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self.*

4 For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.

John 7:24 - *Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.*

1 Corinthians 5:3a - *For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already,...*

1 Corinthians 5:12b - *.....do not ye judge them that are within?*

1 Corinthians 6:5b - *.....Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? no, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren?*

1 Corinthians 6:2 - *Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?*

(There is an area when a person moves in the Spirit that enables him to judge. Study these scriptures but do not abuse them.)

4. Condemnation of those who judge after the flesh.

Matthew 7:1-3 - *Judge not, that ye be not judged.*

2 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

3 And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

Romans 2:1-3 - *Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.*

2 *But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.*

3 *And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?*

Luke 6:37a - *Judge not, and ye shall not be judged:.....*

Psalms 109:17 - *As he loved cursing (judging) , so let it come unto him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him.*

(You reap what you sow.)

5. Conclusion.

Ephesians 4:26a - *Be ye angry, and sin not:.....*

(There is an area of judging that moves in the area of Spirit. You can judge, but do not commit sin. The anger or judging that originates from the flesh will be sin and will be judged. Be wise in judging others. Do not let a critical spirit operate.)

Galatians 6:1 - *Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.*

HOW TO GET THE REVELATION GIFTS OPERATING

STUDY 2

1. Desire them as you walk in love.

1 Corinthians 14:1 - *Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy.*

1 Corinthians 12:31a - *But covet earnestly the best gifts:*

1 Corinthians 14:39b - *.....covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.*

2. Stir up the gift in you by using it.

2 Timothy 1:6b - *.....stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.*

1 Corinthians 14:4a - *He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself;.....*

1 Corinthians 14:32 - *And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.*

(You can use it, or let it sit idle.)

3. Confess that God will reveal Himself today to His servants.

Amos 3:7 - *Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.*

Matthew 11:25b -*thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.*

1 Samuel 3:21 - *And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.*

**4. Confess that God will reveal Himself to you
because you love Him.**

1 Corinthians 2:9b-10 -*Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.*

10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

Psalms 84:11 - *For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*

**5. God reveals Himself to me in deep sleep. Confess this often. Faith
will release.**

Job 4:12-13 - *Now a thing was secretly brought to me, and mine ear received a little thereof.*

13 In thoughts from the visions of the night, when deep sleep falleth on men,

Psalms 16:7 - *I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons.*

**6. Confess that, as Jesus moved by revelations,
so shall you because you are called
to do the same works He did.**

John 14:12 - *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

John 5:19b -*The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do:.....*

John 1:48b -*Before that Philip called thee, when thou wast under the fig tree, I saw thee.*

John 1:50a - *Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, believest thou? thou shalt see greater things than these.*

7. Spirit-led laying on of hands.

2 Timothy 1:6 - *Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.*

1 Timothy 4:14 - *Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.*

Romans 1:11 - *For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established;*

Deuteronomy 34:9a - *And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him:.....*

Daily desire the gifts. Imagine yourself flowing in the gifts. Covet them earnestly. God wants you to express His love to others with the gifts. He wants to express His love to you with the gifts.

1 Corinthians 14:32 - *And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.*

You must release the gifts by faith.

GLORY

STUDY 3

1. I am placed on earth to bring glory to the Lord.

Ephesians 3:21 - *Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.*

(Live and plan so that all glory goes to Jesus and not man.)

Matthew 5:16 - *Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.*

(Confess: I will let my light shine. I shall have good works. The Lord will get the glory.)

1 Corinthians 10:31 - *Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.*

Psalms 115:1a - *Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory,.....*

Isaiah 43:7a - *Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory,.....*

2. I have Jesus' glory and anointing upon me.

Psalms 8:5 - *For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.*

John 17:22 - *And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:*

Hebrews 2:10a - *For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory,.....*

2 Thessalonians 2:14 - *Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of*

our Lord Jesus Christ.

(Note: We walk in the same glory that Jesus walked. Stand tall in this glory today. Confess that you have His glory. Act like you have His glory.)

1 Corinthians 11:7a - *For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God:.....*

Zechariah 2:5 - *For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall of fire round about, and will be the glory in the midst of her.*

1 John 2:20 - *But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.*

1 John 2:27a - *But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.....*

(Anointing and glory are similar. Walk out in the anointing and glory of Jesus today.)

Psalms 84:11 - *For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*

(Confess: The Lord is my Energy today. He is my Shield from sin, sickness and poverty. He gives me favor. His glory and anointing are upon me. I will not fail Him. No good thing will He withhold from me today.)

3. I have a greater glory than Moses.

2 Corinthians 3:7-10 - *But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away:*

8 How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?

9 For if the ministration of condemnation be glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.

10 For even that which was made glorious had no glory in this respect, by reason of the glory that excelleth.

Matthew 11:11b - *.....Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.*

(My position in Christ is far greater than John or Moses. I will arise by faith in Jesus' Name and do the job that the Lord has called me to do.)

GOD'S WORD

STUDY 4

1. GOD'S Word is in your mouth.

Luke 21:15 - *For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.*

Romans 10:8b - *.....The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart:.....*

Exodus 4:15b - *.....I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do.*

Numbers 22:38b - *.....the word that God putteth in my mouth, that shall I speak.*

Numbers 23:5a - *And the LORD put a word in Balaam's mouth,.....*

2 Samuel 23:2 - *The spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue.*

Psalms 81:10b - *.....open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.*

Isaiah 51:16 - *And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people.*

(Jesus and His believers.)

Isaiah 59:21 - *As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.*

2. Jesus spoke the words of His Father.

John 14:10b -*the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.*

John 14:24b -*the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.*

John 5:19 - *Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.*

3. We are also to speak His words.

1 Peter 2:21 - *For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:*

1 John 4:17 - *Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.*

John 14:12 - *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

Matthew 17:20 - *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

Luke 10:16a - *He that heareth you heareth me;.....*

2 Corinthians 5:19b -*hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.*

1 Peter 4:11a - *If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God;.....*

Isaiah 50:4 - *The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.*

(This is applicable to Jesus, but also to us since we share His life and ministry.)

4. God makes your mouth like a sharp sword.

Ephesians 6:17b -*the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:*

Isaiah 49:2a - *And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft;.....*

Hebrews 4:12a - *For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword,.....*

Revelation 1:16b -*out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword:.....*

5. God confirms His Word.

Isaiah 44:26a - *That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers;.....*

Exodus 8:13a - *And the LORD did according to the word of Moses;.....*

Mark 11:23b -*he shall have whatsoever he saith.*

Mark 5:28 - *For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.*

Matthew 12:37 - *For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.*

1 Kings 17:1 - *And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.*

1 Kings 17:14 - *For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.*

Believe that God puts His Word into your mouth. Expect it to happen. Never assume that you are always speaking the Word of God. However, expect it to happen. Expect to have words of counsel and wisdom daily.

Have confidence that God is putting divine counsel into your mouth. Expect your words to set the captives free.

HID IN GOD

STUDY 5

1. Hid in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:3b -*your life is hid with Christ in God.*

Isaiah 32:2 - *And a man (Jesus) shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.*

(Confess that Christ is your hiding place today. Confess that He is like a great rock overshadowing your loved ones. Confess that He is your river of supply today in the midst of many needs. Believe it. You have it.)

2. Hid under His wings.

Psalms 17:8 - *Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,*

Psalms 57:1 - *Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast.*

Psalms 91:4a - *He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust:..*

(Regardless of your position or need, confess that you or your loved ones are hid under His wings today. Your faith in Jesus will deliver you.)

Isaiah 49:2 - *And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his quiver hath he hid me;*

(Confess: He has hid me in His quiver. I am abiding in His presence. I will speak His words, think His thoughts. I will do His works today. I am like a polished shaft. What I do, I do well. I am a success. I expect victories today. I expect good things to happen.)

3. Hid in His house (presence).

Psalm 27:5 - *For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.*

(Confess that you or your loved ones are hid in the secret of His presence today. Confess that you are **UPON A ROCK** right now.)

Psalm 31:20 - *Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.*

(Confess that Jesus is hiding you from strife, turmoil and the critical tongue of unbelief. Stand tall in the Word of God.)

Psalm 91:1 - *He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.*

(Confess that the one you are praying for right now is abiding under the very shadow of the Lord. God **IS WATCHING OVER** that loved one.)

Psalm 32:7 - *Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.*

(Confess that God is hiding you or your loved ones from trouble right now.)

4. A hiding place in times of trouble.

Psalm 9:9-10 - *The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. 10 And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.*

(Confess: Lord I trust You today. I seek You today. You are my hiding place today. God will not forsake me. Now, love the Lord. Worship Him. Let confidence build into your spirit.)

5. God is a strong hiding place.

Psalm 71:7 - *I am as a wonder unto many; but thou art my strong refuge.*

(Drink in this. God is a strong refuge for you today. Close your eyes. Relax. Think on this. Others may forsake you but Jesus is a strong hiding place for you right now.)

RICHES

STUDY 6

1. God's attitude, in the Old Testament, toward riches.

Genesis 13:2 - *And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.*

1 Chronicles 29:12 - *Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all.*

2 Chronicles 17:5b - *.....all Judah brought to Jehoshaphat presents; and he had riches and honour in abundance.*

Deuteronomy 28:12-13a - *The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.*

13 And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail;.....

2. God's attitude, in the New Testament, towards riches.

Philippians 4:19 - *But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*

Matthew 6:33 - *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

2 Peter 1:3b - *.....his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:*

(Through Christ, spiritual and financial blessings are available as we believe and take.)

1 Corinthians 3:21b - *.....all things are yours;*

Matthew 27:57b - *.....a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus'*

disciple:

(Jesus did not tell this man to give his money away. This man loved Jesus and not his money. He could be trusted.)

3 John 2 - *Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.*

Luke 4:18a - *The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor;*

(Preach to the poor and God prospers them. The few cases of poverty in the New Testament were due either to famine or the transition period. The gospel is first preached to the poor. Then God prospers them.)

3. Riches are a blessing from God.

Deuteronomy 8:18a - *But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth,.....*

Psalm 23:1-2a - *The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures:.....*

(Not dry poverty stricken pastures.)

Proverbs 10:22 - *The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.*

4. Riches are for the upright.

Psalm 84:11b - *.....no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*

Psalm 34:10b - *.....no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*

Proverbs 22:4 - *By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.*

Proverbs 8:21 - *That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.*

Proverbs 15:6a - *That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.....*

Isaiah 1:19-20a - *If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:
20 But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword;.....*

Psalms 21:2 - *Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah.*

Meditate on these verses. Confess that God will not withhold anything good from the upright. Confess that you love God. Confess that you will inherit substance both spiritually and financially. Confess that God will fill your bank account.

Keep in balance. Do not love money. Put Jesus first. Believe for finances to meet your needs and to proclaim the gospel.

DELIVERANCE FROM FEAR

STUDY 7

2 Timothy 1:7 - *For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.*

Romans 8:15 - *For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.*

1. Fear brings the enemy.

Proverbs 29:15 - *The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.*

Job 3:25 - *For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.*

Proverbs 10:24 - *The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.*

(One man was dying. God spoke to him and said, "Do not fear and I will heal you." God healed him. One man feared wasps. He was finally killed by wasps. That which you greatly fear will probably park in your living room tonight.)

2. Fear will spread and weaken a group.

Deuteronomy 20:8b - *.....What man is there that is fearful and fainthearted? let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint as well as his heart.*

3. Fearful ones cannot win the battle of faith.

Judges 7:3b - *.....Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.*

(The final number was three hundred, before God could give victory. Three hundred without fear was far better than thirty-two thousand with fear.)

4. Fear will destroy you.

Deuteronomy 28:60 - *Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee.*

Jeremiah 42:16 - *Then it shall come to pass, that the sword, which ye feared, shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine, whereof ye were afraid, shall follow close after you there in Egypt; and there ye shall die.*

(Fear to stand up and obey God brought destruction.)

5. Fear is destroyed by joy.

Ephesians 5:20 - *Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;*

Philippians 4:4 - *Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice.*

1 Thessalonians 5:18 - *In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.*

Joshua 6:20b - *.....the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat,.....*

(Satan's program is fed by fear. His program is destroyed with joy and positive faith. So rejoice the moment you feel like being afraid or frustrated or confused. Leap for joy.)

6. Fear is overcome with positive faith.

Ephesians 6:10 - *Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.*

(Confess: I am strong. I am not afraid. "Joy" in the midst of your pressure.)

Isaiah 35:3-4 - *Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees.*

4 Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompense; he will come and save you.

(Strengthen the weak hands. Refuse to be fearful. Come alive. Be strong by faith. God will bring you through.)

7. Fear is overcome by perfect love.

1 John 4:18a - *There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear:.....*

8. Overcome fear by looking to Jesus, not problems.

Hebrews 12:2 - *Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

(Look to Jesus as revealed in the Word of God.)

Deuteronomy 20:1a - *When thou goest out to battle against thine enemies, and seest horses, and chariots, and a people more than thou, be not afraid of them: for the LORD thy God is with thee,.....*

2 Chronicles 20:15b - *.....Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.*

Jesus tells you to commit it to Him. Look to Him. Your problem says, "Fear me. Look how big I am." Refuse to look at the problem. It brings fear. Look to your victory. Expect a break through.

HOW TO KEEP FREE FROM THE SPIRITS OF OPPRESSION

STUDY 8

Galatians 5:1 - *Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.*

John 8:36 - *If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.*

1. Take your freedom by faith.

Ephesians 6:10b - *.....be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.*

Ephesians 4:27 - *Neither give place to the devil.*

Colossians 1:13 - *Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:*

Colossians 2:15 - *And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.*

Luke 10:19 - *Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.*

(This is your position. You have to take it by faith. Declare it. Stand on the Word. Get stubborn with the devil. This is your heritage.)

2. Resist the devil.

1 Peter 5:8-10a - *Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:*

9 Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

3. A loving spirit needed.

Matthew 5:44b -*Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;*

Colossians 3:14 - *And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.*

Proverbs 10:12 - *Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.*

(Refuse to be hateful and mean. Confess love.)

4. A forgiving spirit needed.

Mark 11:25 - *And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.*

(An unforgiving spirit lets the enemy on you again.)

5. A tender spirit needed.

Isaiah 53:2a - *For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant,.....*

(Jesus did not bite back. He was tender. You be like Him.)

6. Avail yourself of the blood of Jesus.

Revelation 12:11a - *And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony;.....*

(Learn to ask forgiveness when you sin. Learn to stand tall in His love and grace. Satan must respect the blood.)

7. You must forsake sin.

John 8:11b -*Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.*

John 5:14b -*sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.*

(Determine to stand fast.)

John 8:32b -*the truth shall make you free.*

Stand tall in God's Word. Confess deliverance daily. Confess your healing based on God's Word. Do not accept what you feel or see in the natural.

Be strong today. Meditate on this. Confess your strength. Confess that you have been delivered from the power of darkness. Imagine yourself sitting in heavenly places with Jesus today.

Ephesians 2:6 - *And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:*

STUDY 9

1. Believer's authority.

John 14:12 - *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

Matthew 17:20 - *And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.*

Luke 9:1 - *Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.*

Luke 10:1a - *After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two.....*

Luke 10:9a - *And heal the sick that are therein,.....*

Luke 10:16a - *He that heareth you heareth me;.....*

Luke 10:19a - *Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions,.....*

Acts 3:6a - *Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee:.*

Acts 9:34b - *.....Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed.....*

Acts 9:40b - *.....Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes:.....*

Acts 14:10 - *(Paul) Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.*

Mark 16:17-18 - *And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;*

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Ephesians 1:19-20a - *And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe,*

*according to the working of his mighty power,
20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead,.....*

Matthew 16:19a - *And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven:.....*

Matthew 18:19 - *Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.*

2. Believer's mantle.

John 1:16 - *And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.*

1 John 2:27 - *But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.*

Matthew 11:11b - *.....Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.*

1 Corinthians 3:21 - *Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours;*

Ephesians 1:3b - *.....who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:*

2 Peter 1:3b - *...his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness,.....*

3. Believer's equipment.

Luke 4:32b - *.....his word was with power.*

John 17:8 - *For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.*

John 17:17 - *Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.*

John 8:32 - *And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.*

John 17:18 - *As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.*

John 17:22 - *And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:*

John 17:23b - *.....that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.*

John 15:9-10 - *As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.
10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.*

John 13:34 - *A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.*

4. Believer's position.

Colossians 1:19 - *For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;*

Colossians 2:9-10 - *For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.
10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:*

John 1:16 - *And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.*

Ephesians 2:5-6 - *Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:*

5. Believer's relationship.

John 1:12 - *But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:*

1 John 3:1-3 - *Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.*

2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

Galatians 4:6-7 - *And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.*

7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Romans 8:16-17 - *The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.*

Hebrews 2:10-11 - *For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. 11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,*

Philippians 2:15 - *That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;*

6. *Believer's inheritance.*

Hebrews 1:2 - *Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;*

Galatians 4:6-7 - *And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.*

7 *Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.*

Romans 8:16-17 - *The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.*

Psalms 16:5 - *The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.*

Revelation 3:20 - *Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.*

Every believer has Christ's full authority. Each believer has His mantle and His anointing.

You have His equipment, Word, commission, glory and love. You have His position as sons before the Father. Remember, Jesus is the Head. You are adopted sons.

Read and reread these scriptures. Release the Christ that is within you.
